## Assignment 4 : MIT 11.125 Assignment-Performance Assessment

**Assignment:** Design an authentic performance task for students that would result in a product. Develop a rubric that you would use to assess students' performance on this task. Once the task and rubric are designed, assess your own work and that of one other colleague.

Identify the *learning outcomes, grade level(s), curriculum area(s)* that this task is designed to address. Complete a performance task *plan* (blueprint).

 In the description of the task, include the *context*, *purpose*, and *audience* of the students' performance. You may write this either directly to the intended students, or to a colleague who will assess your plan.

• The performance assessment may be administered to a group or the whole class, but you will need to be able to assess each *individual* student's performance.

 Assume that students have been engaged in similar authentic tasks *prior* to this performance assessment. The assessment *must* include a product, and *may* also include selected response or essay questions.

Develop a rubric that you would use to assess the product. List the *criteria* that you will use to determine if students have acquired the intended knowledge and skill. Include the *rating scale* that you will use.

 Write a brief paragraph describing what you anticipate might be the range of performance on your task in your intended audience. • Assess your own "performance" on *this assignment* using the rubric supplied by the instructor.

• Examine the performance task blueprint and rubric designed by someone else in this class. Give your colleague feedback, using the same rubric as above.
