Please draw the syntactic trees for the following sentences. When the sentence involves Wh-movment, indicate the place in the tree where the wh-word was moved from. Mark this position with a t (trace). Indicate the movement path with a dotted/dashed line. Be sure and be precise about its landing site. For example, make sure that we can tell that an element is in the Specifier position of a CP.

Use what we have learned in class as well as your notes and readings about how best to represent the sentence in a syntactic tree. Think about what part of speech and element is and what its relationship is to other elements in the sentence.
