REPORT REQUIREMENTS

NOTE: Drawings and images must all be from one project. If you remodeled your project all drawings and renderings must reflect the “new” model.

- 1) Below is a list of the minimum required drawings (each image or drawing has to be on a separate page, your report should be 9 – 11 pages long) :
 - a. TITLE PAGE – NAME, COURSE, YEAR, IMAGE IF YOU LIKE
 - b. WRITING – TEXT DESCRIBING COTTAGE – spelling counts – IMAGES IF YOU LIKE
 - c. SITE PLAN AND ROOF PLAN OF BUILDING – FIT TO ONE PAGE
 - Include trees, the oceans edge, etc.
 - Print on paper from AutoCAD
 - d. FLOOR PLAN – FIT TO ONE PAGE
 - Must include dimensions, notes, north arrow, room names & scale bar
 - Must include details such as window and door frames, etc.
 - Print on paper from AutoCAD
 - e. ELEVATION – FIT TO ONE PAGE
 - Must include dimensions, notes, & scale bar
 - Print on paper from AutoCAD
 - f. AXON MODEL ON A WHITE BACKGROUND – FIT TO ONE PAGE
 - Rendered in 3D Viz with white background “NO COLOR”
 - g. INTERIOR RENDERING
 - Rendered with Textures and background image in windows and doors
 - h. EXTERIOR RENDERING
 - Rendered with Textures and background image
 - i. DIGITAL PHOTO OF 3D MODEL FABRICATED MODEL
 - We will provide you with these unless you want to take your own, the photos will be posted on STUDIOMIT by Monday May 6th.

- 2) FORMATING – Based on comments from returned assignment throughout the term. Be certain to print the document to the highest quality using color if needed and bound – one staple is best.
- 3) STUDIOMIT - Required materials listed above must also be placed on line in a folder title with your user name. Each image, dwg or text should be uploaded as a single image and a pdf of the final report if you can figure out how to create a pdf.

 - b. Additional Elevation
- 5) PRINTING – You can print from Autocad (Better lines than photoshop), you can also print from Photoshop
