- drawing trees using X-bar theory and avoiding triangles, in English and other languages
- identifying constituents using constituency tests
- wh-movement, head-movement, NP-movement; figuring out D-structures and S-structures of sentences
- syntactic well-formedness conditions like the EPP and Shortest Move
- figuring out relations between propositions (presupposition, entailment, implicature)
- Binding Theory
- giving meanings for quantifiers (e.g., what does most mean?)
