- Absorption
- Distribution
- Metabolism
- Excretion

### ADME

#### Excretion

- In feces (how did it get there? Discuss)
- In urine (Kidneys)

#### Drugs with funky excretion

#### **Amphetamine:**

A large amount of amphetamine is excreted renally without being metabolized.

Amphetamine is a weak base with a pKa near urine's pH.

Acidic urine causes fast excretion

Alkaline urine causes slow excretion

#### Playing with ADME:

- Alcohol enemas
- Taking a huge amount of baking soda with amphetamine
- Taking Tagamet (cimetidine) with MDMA (ecstasy), opioids, many other drugs. Tagamet inhibits liver enzymes, thus inhibiting which of these: A, D, M, or E?
- Taking grapefruit juice

#### Playing with ADME:

- Snorting everything
- Smoking everything
- Injecting everything
- Depot injections (inject a month's worth of drugs into the muscle, design for slow absorption)
- Chewing time-release pills
- Dissecting time-release pills (Concerta)

#### Playing with ADME:

- Snorting Viagra before snorting something else (especially before snorting something vasoconstrictive, like what?)
- Inhaling albuterol before smoking crack (yes, people do this)
- Taking MAOIs with your DMT to enable absorption – this is called ayahuasca and was discovered hundreds of years ago
