Topic: You may choose from one of the following topics.

Topic 1: Write about a person who has had a great impact on your world outlook, and who you are today.

Topic 2: Write about an event that has had a great impact on your world outlook, and who you are today.

Grading (10% of class grade):

Content: 5 points (convincing/enticing)

Degree of sophistication of the language: 3 points (when appropriate, incorporate the grammar, sentence patterns, and vocabulary we have learned into your essay)

Over-all structure: 2 points (make sure each paragraph has a focus and the paragraphs relate to one another in a logical way)
